Self-Interview (5~10min long)	After submission of application, the guideline for Self-Interview Video will be provided via email within a week. Send the video within a week after receiving the guideline.
Announcement	Result to be announced personally via email/text message
Orientation (OT)	Online OT via ZOOM (link will be provided via email to those who pass the interview) MUST ATTEND before volunteering

Do's and Don'ts

- After submitting the application, you must send self-interview video to complete the application process.
- The guideline for self-interview will be provided within a week after the submission of the application via email.
- If you don't attend the orientation, you CANNOT participate this program.
- To do CCAP, you must be available to participate at least 2~3times a month. Class dates are scheduled by the schools.
